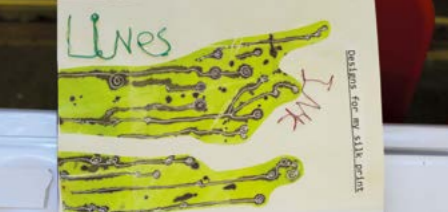

We offer:

- Learning through making, developed and delivered by qualified teachers (**GCSE, AS Level**)
- Experienced behaviour management support with engagement, attendance, personal skills
- Senior leader liaison with school and multi-agency teams where necessary
- Arts Awards Centre for delivery and verification of awards
- Progress tracking with a half-termly comprehensive report
